Offered as a free software-as-a-service to institutions across India, IRINS is currently adopted by over 1,700 organizations and more than 2.5 lakh faculty members, serving as a vital platform for managing research activities and enhancing institutional visibility.

The system integrates effortlessly with institutional HR systems, repositories, grant management tools, and global scholarly databases such as Scopus, ORCID, and Google Scholar.
