The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) located in the Infocity, Gandhinagar. UCE Burla, its former name was officially changed to its current name on 10th June 2009, as a result of a resolution by the Government of Odisha to accord it with the status of a unitary university. Situated in a 350-acre residential campus near the Hirakud Dam, it offers undergraduate, postgraduate, and Ph.D. programs across various engineering disciplines, serving over 5,200 students with a focus on technical education and research.
